



# 2021 ROSE of PINOTNOIR

#### THE VINTAGE

The 2021 growing season in Napa and Sonoma counties will be remembered by its exceptional quality and concentration of flavor. While there was hardly any rainfall in the late winter and spring months, this led to a moderate crop load on the vines that required less management to promote flavor. Heat spikes in the summer months were infrequent which allowed the small clusters and berries to ripen at a steady pace. A slightly earlier harvest than average, the 2021 Trois Noix wines are highly aromatic and rich in flavor and structure.

## **TASTING NOTES**

The 2021 Trois Noix Rosé of Pinot Noir showcases a mercurial spectrum of pale pink, orange, and straw hues. Gentle pressing of the berries at harvest gives way to aromatics of freshly sliced cherry, orange peel, and white flowers, all of which are enveloped by a gravelly minerality. The palette is energetic with citruslaced acidity, but is nuanced by a core of juicy red fruits and florals leading to a persistent finish.

#### **PAIRINGS**

Savor this by the pool or on the patio with light salads, lean fish dishes, or grilled pork tenderloin with an herbed cream sauce.
