



## 2021 CABERNET SAUVIGNON MUIR-HANNA VINEYARD

### THE VINTAGE

The 2021 growing season in Napa and Sonoma counties will be remembered by its exceptional quality and concentration of flavor. While there was hardly any rainfall in the late winter and spring months, this led to a moderate crop load on the vines that required less management to promote flavor. Heat spikes in the summer months were infrequent which allowed the small clusters and berries to ripen at a steady pace. A slightly earlier harvest than average, the 2021 Trois Noix wines are highly aromatic and rich in flavor and structure.

### TASTING NOTES

Our second consecutive release of this wine, our 2021 Muir-Hanna Cabernet Sauvignon is a natural ode to classic Napa Valley with a modern framework. Bursting from the glass is an interplay of red currents, dark olives, and sandalwood, all enveloped by gorgeous florals of rose. The mouthfeel is focused and structured while still feeling lifted, qualities that make this wine age worthy if desired.

Mushroom risotto, herb crusted rack of lamb, butter chicken, or a margarita pizza.
